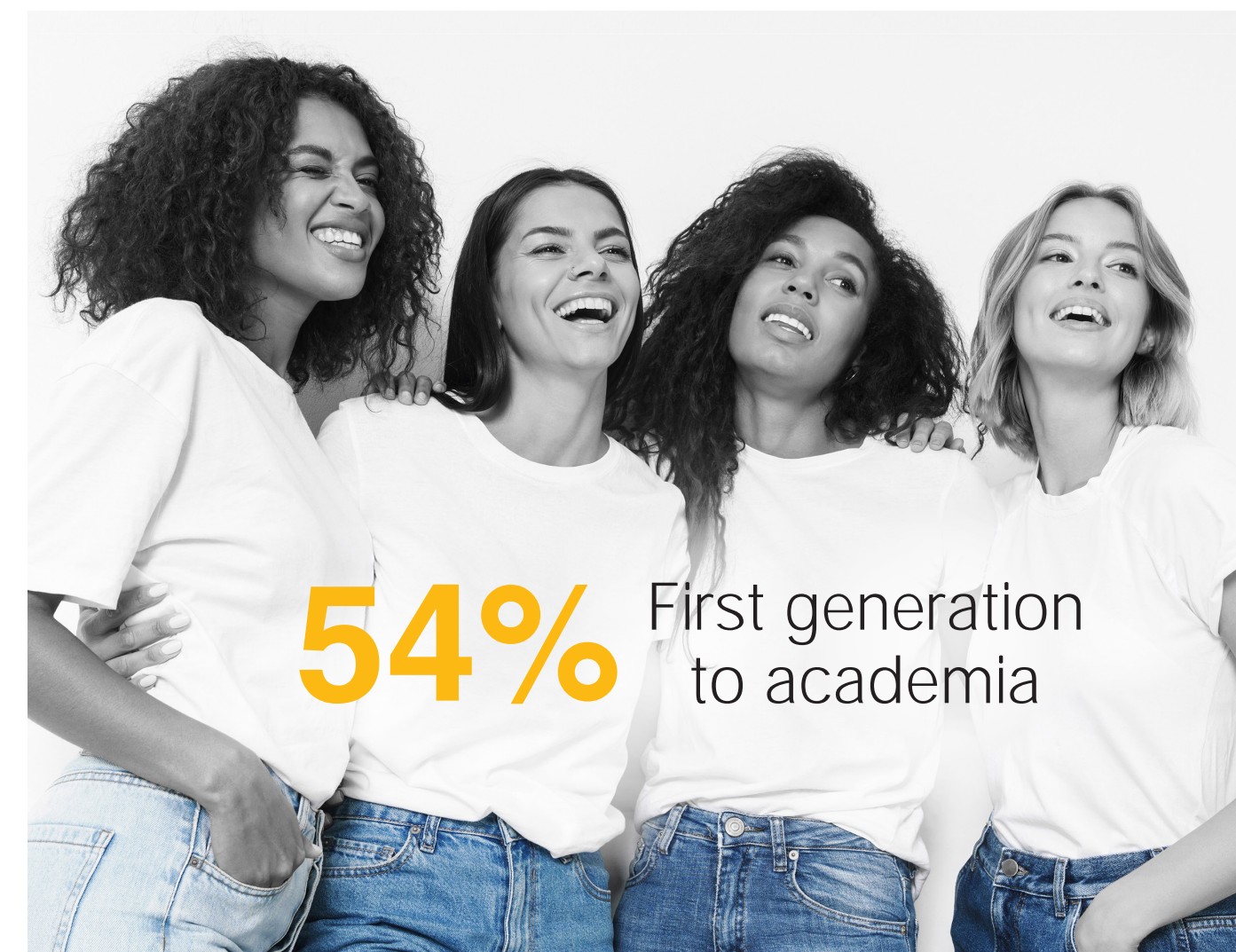
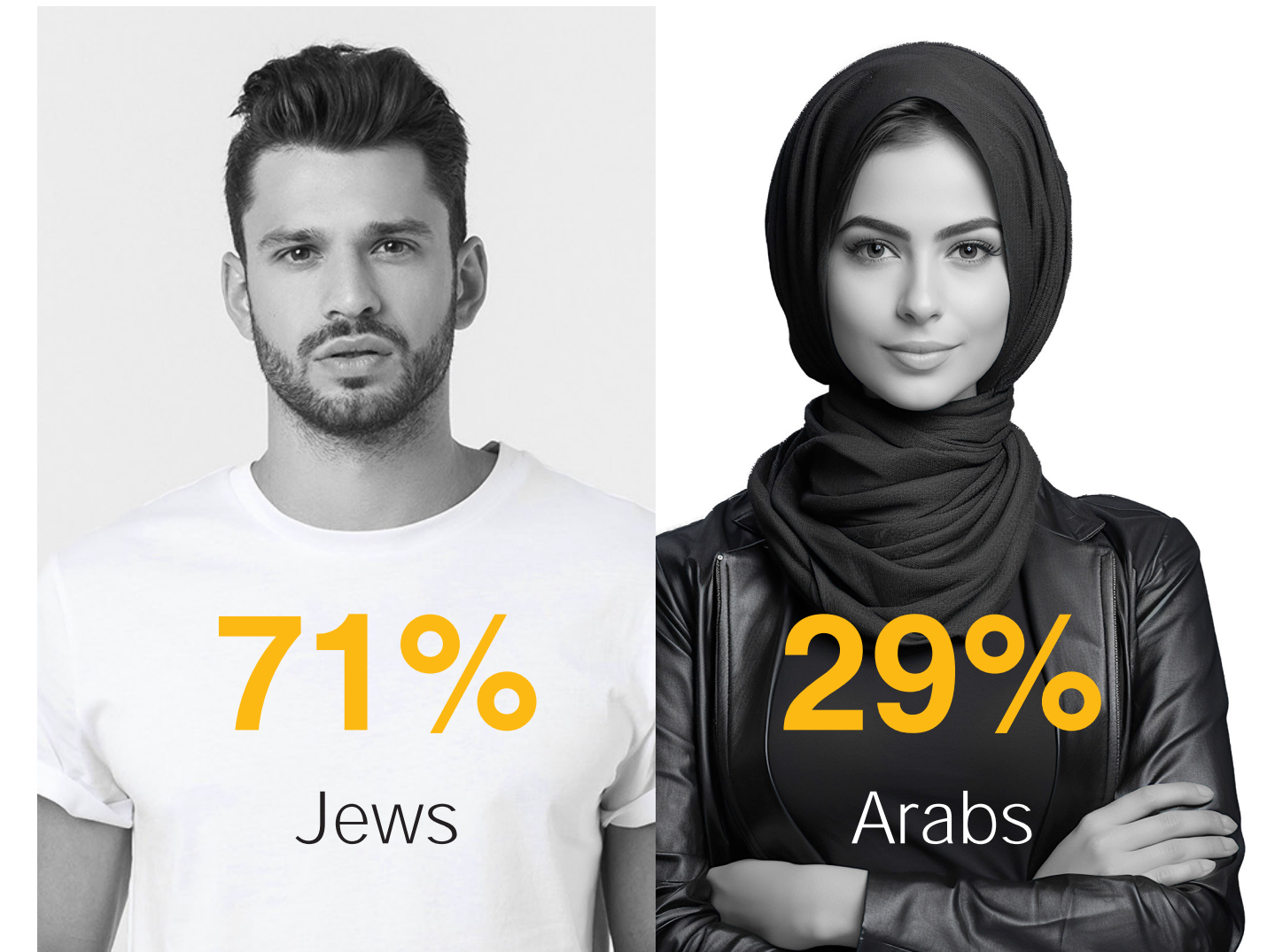

Upward mobility Graduates from challenging socio-economic backgrounds achieve upward mobility, entering stable, well-paying professions.

Community Service in Times of War

Since October 7, 2023 our faculty and students have provided essential support to those affected by the war:

Optometry: Free eye exams and glasses for displaced residents.

Communication Disorders: Free hearing exams and developed a protocol for diagnosing war-related hearing damage.

Social Work: Support for soldiers with PTSD.

Laboratory Science: Volunteering to replace reservist lab technicians.

Photographic Communications: Digital preservation of damaged communities in collaboration with the Department of Antiquities.

Student Reservists received scholarships and special tutoring.

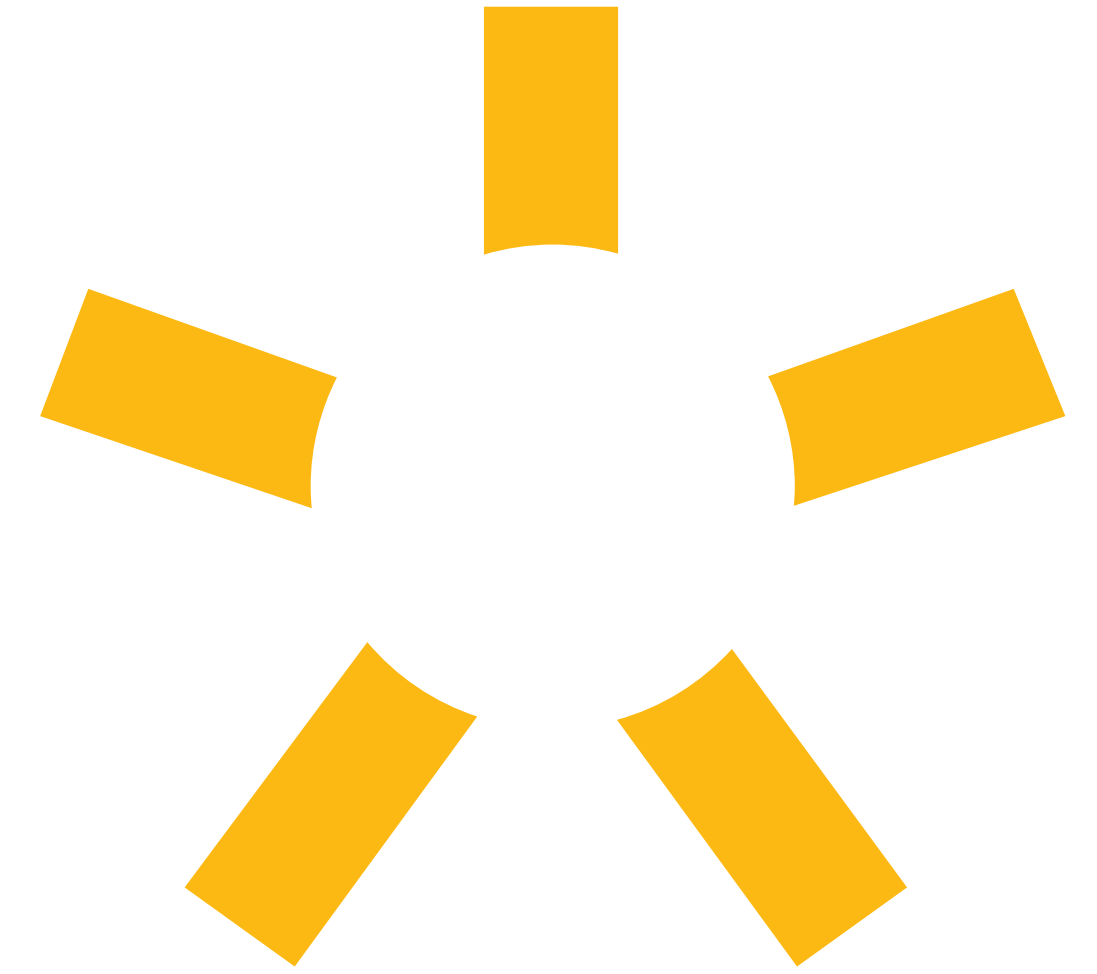
